Recycling and Waste Disposal

TRASH DROP OFF: - Disposal fee \$1.00 per bag under 30 gallons
 \$2.50 per bag at 30-35 gallons
 \$5.00 per bag over 35 gallons

BATTERIES: Includes Automotive Batteries, Rechargeable Batteries, Alkaline Batteries, Button cells.

NEWSPAPERS, MAGAZINES & OFFICE PAPER (JUNK MAIL): Can be mixed together - Includes catalogs, telephone books, glossy inserts and paperback books as well as colored paper, white paper, wrapping paper and junk mail. Any color or type of paper can be in this category **except** brown Kraft bags and boxboard. Hard Cover books in separate container.

BROWN KRAFT BAGS, BOXBOARD, CORRUGATED CARDBOARD : **NO wax-coated cardboard, cardboard soiled with food waste.** Remove excess tape. Staples are OK. Please no strings, handles, or bags with plastic layers.

TIN CANS: Please rinse. Labels are OK. Flattening is not required. Separate from aluminum cans (A magnet will stick to tin but not to aluminum).

AEROSOLS: Any aerosol can, spray paint, oven cleaners, 1#, 2# propane tanks, air fresheners, degreasers, cooking sprays, Whipped Cream, Etc.

ALUMINUM CANS, FOIL AND FOOD TRAYS: Please rinse. Labels OK. Flattening not required, **Snack bags and candy wrappers are not aluminum foil!**

GLASS (ALL COLORS): Please rinse. Clear, Green, Blue, Amber bottles and jars, Dishes, Window, Mirror, Ceramic, Pyrex and drinking glasses are acceptable, **No crystal, lids, metal, wood or light bulbs.**

#1 thru #7 PLASTIC: Please rinse. Look for the recycling number stamped on the bottom of the container. Includes all labeled rigid plastic containers and lids. Labels are OK, please crush larger containers. Tubs and automotive product containers are acceptable as long as they are completely drained of fluid. **No vinyl siding, Styrofoam, syringes or medical**

devices – call for proper disposal options for these items.

PLASTIC BAGS: Only plastic bags that are labeled #2 or #4, or have been identified as such. **No chip bags, candy bags, cereal box liners or woven animal feed bags.**

MOTOR OIL: Oil Filters, Transmission fluid, brake fluid, Power steering fluid

LIGHT BULBS: Fluorescent; 4 foot, 8 foot, CFL, U-tube, Circular, or HID-High Intensity Discharge.

ELECTRONICS: - TV's, computer monitors, printers, cell phones, DVD players, stereo components, etc. **Please DO NOT place items such as vacuum cleaners, microwaves, hair dryers, irons, toasters in with electronics they go in the scrap metal bin.**

SCRAP METAL: In container outside recycling center.

TIRES: FEES: Passenger car tires without rims \$2.00ea. with rims \$4.00ea. larger than 17" are \$7.00 and \$14.00

THE FOLLOWING ARE ACCEPTABLE IN LYNDONVILLE ONLY

Special Wastes: Lead fishing sinkers, 20#, 100# Propane cylinders, Printer/Toner cartridges.

Household Hazardous Waste: BY APPOINTMENT ONLY, Monday-Friday, June through end of September in Lyndonville and special events throughout the district. Call for details.
