TOWN OF CONCORD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE-ARTICLE 4, SECTION 1 SPEED REGULATIONS

On August 3rd, 2006 the Concord Selectboard adopted a Traffic Ordinance. The purpose of this Ordinance is to establish special traffic regulations on public highways within the Town of Concord, Vermont.

This Ordinance Amendment was adopted on February 4th, 2025. It will take effect on April 5th, 2025 unless a petition signed by at least five percent (5%0 of the voters of Concord is filed with the Town Clerk by March 21st, 2025, asking for a vote to disprove the Amended Ordinance. If a petition is received, the Concord Selectboard will warn a special meeting and the voters may vote on that question. 24 V.S.A. *§* 1973.

AMENDMENT ARTICLE 4 SPEED REGULATIONS

Section 1. The Maximum speed limit for any vehicular traffic on Vermont Route 2 within the Town of Concord shall be the same as those limits established and posted by the State of Vermont, to wit:

US Route 2 eastbound beginning at the Kirby/Concord town line at 50MPH a distance of 1.5 miles to the 40MPH sign, a maximum speed of 40MPH entering easterly 1,046 feet which is the beginning of 30MPH easterly for 0.55 miles to the 40MPH sign, then 1,055 feet easterly to the 50MPH sign easterly of the town highway #6 and then 50MPH to the Concord/Lunenburg town line for 8.2 miles.
